Mrs Sundbye is currently Head of the Section for Environmental Monitoring and Data in the Water and Knowledge Department at the Norwegian Environment Agency. The section has the coordination responsibility for all monitoring programs and for the assessment of status and trends in the ecological condition of Norway's main ecosystem types. The section has also the coordination responsibility for research and development and for collaboration with the European Environment Agency.

Mrs Sundbye has been working at the Norwegian Environment Agency (and former Norwegian Climate and Pollution Agency and Norwegian Pollution Control Authority) since 1992. She has led several sections and units at the Agency since 2006, covering issues such as environmental monitoring, management of marine areas, nature mapping, assessment of ecological condition and ecosystem accounting. Her expertise covers a wide array of topics, ranging from soil pollution to the implementation of the EU water directive and land-use planning. She also has experience with international collaboration both within the EU and OSPAR.
